## **HOW WE STUDY ENGLISH LANGUAGE**

It involves reading, analysing and discussing a range of texts and writing for different purposes and audiences.

## WHAT WE STUDY

English Language IGCSE comprises of three assessments

• Paper 1: externally assessed written examination (2 hours 15 minutes) 70%

Reading section A of the Edexcel Anthology for IGCSE and an unseen passage.

Writing on a topic taken from a piece from section A of the Edexcel Anthology and writing to inform, explain and describe.

 Paper 2: externally assessed written examination (1 hour 30 minutes) 30% Reading section B of the Edexcel Anthology for IGCSE

A selection of poems and texts.

Writing to argue, persuade and advise.

Writing to explore, imagine and entertain.

Students will study a range of spoken, written and multimodal texts. They will develop skills to understand the following aspects of unseen and prepared passages: voice, imagery and appeal to senses; the writers' thoughts and feelings; techniques of persuasion; sentence length and variety. Students will develop skills to write responses to prepared contexts and in response to novel situations.
